## Notice regarding commencement of operations at new factory in Malaysia

New factory will expand production capacity in ASEAN region, and accelerate EMS Business growth strategy

KAGA ELECTRONICS CO., LTD. (Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, President & COO: Ryoichi Kado; hereinafter the "Company") hereby announces that it has constructed a new factory on the outskirts of Penang, Malaysia. This factory, which commenced full-fledged operation in October 2022, will augment production capacity for the EMS business in the ASEAN region.

## 1. Purpose of the New Factory Construction

Since the Company's foundation in 1968, we have expanded our business fields by catering to the diverse needs of our customers with the corporate philosophy of "Everything we do is for our customers." In recent years, the EMS (Electronics Manufacturing Services) business in particulars, which has been positioned as its core growth driver, the Company has responded to increasingly frequent requests from customers by forging ahead with the expansion of production sites both domestically and overseas, and currently operates 21 factories in 10 countries.

In 2000, the Company established local subsidiary KAGA COMPONENTS (MALAYSIA) SDN. BHD. on the outskirts of Penang, Malaysia, where it has been manufacturing power supply products, sanitary equipment, power tools, and electrical equipment substrates for consumer electronics. The semiconductor shortage and the disruption of the global distribution network that occurred after the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic are in the process of being resolved, and demand from customers is recovering sharply. Taking this opportunity, the Company made the decision to renew the factory building and facilities, which had suffered from age-related deterioration, with the aim of further improving production quality and efficiency, and putting in place a framework that can respond to robust demand.

The new factory's location within the same industrial estate as the existing factory and about 3.5 km from it in a straight line is optimal in terms of both cost and personnel, as it enables control not only of relocation expenses but also of outflows of human resources. In addition to using this increase in production

capacity to increase orders from existing customers and address the need for distributed manufacturing in the ASEAN region, the Company will also work to win orders for new projects from local companies, aiming for net sales of ¥10 billion within five years of the commencement of operations.
